



Scripture Background


1 Corinthians 12

Church Membership

Man Made Membership

- Remain on rolls and never show up or give.
- Be a CEO Christian (Christmas, Easter Only)
- Be a revered member by giving a nice sum each year but never lift a finger in service or ministry.

Biblical Member

- Gives without qualification
- Views the tithes and offerings as joyous giving.
- Serves and ministers as a natural way of doing things.

The Church

- The Church is to be unified in its mission, purpose, ministries and activities.
- Everyone has a function.
- Everyone should be **functioning**.
- Everyone should have a **role**.

One of the ongoing questions you should ask yourself and God in prayer is: **"How can I best** serve my church?" You should never ask yourself if you should be serving your church.
