
Church and Family

Ephesians 5:22-26

Wives, <u>submit</u> to your own **husbands** as to the Lord, for the husband is the <u>head</u> of the wife as Christ is the <u>head</u> of the **church**. He is the Savior of the body. • These passages remind us that, just as we are supposed to sacrifice and love our **families**unconditionally, so are we to love those churches where God has placed us.


