

Cake Walk Instructions

Place ten (10) numbers in a circle on the ground as if you were playing musical chairs. The number on the ground can vary based on the size of the gathering and the expected amount of interest in the Cake Walk.

Place numbers on the ground, starting with one (1) and going as high as necessary, depending on the number of people playing. Now take a number and place by each pastry. Have a nice display of the goodies on some tables so that everyone can see them.

Start some music on the stereo. Instruct the participants to walk around until the music stops. Participants should be standing on a number when the music stops. Stop the music.

Draw a number out of box or other container. The participant who is standing on the corresponding number wins the prize for that round. Then that number is removed from the ground. The next round starts.

Tips: Depending on how many cakes/goodies you want to give away will correlate to how many games you play. (i.e. six (6) cakes six (6) cake walk games)
