Kingdomtide



...”Jesus went to Galilee and told the good news that comes from God. He said, The time has come! God’s kingdom will soon be here. Turn back to God and believe the good news!” Mark 1:14-15 (CEV)

SEASON COLOR: Green, symbolizing growth in Christ and growth in the life of the church.

The season of **Kingdomtide** is the newest of all of the seasons of the Christian Calendar, dating back to the late 1930’s. **Kingdomtide** is observed in the autumn period of the year, the time between the ending of Pentecost and the beginning of Advent. The **Kingdomtide** season gives time to focus our attention to the Eternal Presence of Christ and His kingship, with the parallel emphasis upon man’s stewardship. It also celebrates Christ as King and Sovereign of the world, emphasizing God’s dominion over all of creation. God’s kingdom expresses His Lordship over His people, the world and where man’s challenges are in our daily lives and every area of our existence.

This time of the year is also known as Ordinary Time, which comes from the word “ordinal” which means counted time from the last Sunday in August (August 25) continuing through to Advent – the first Sunday in December (December 1)
